- ___ AA-TULSA _ Major changes announced for an American Airlines depot at Tulsa
- ___ ABORTION _ State Supreme Court rejects a pair of abortion-related laws, one requiring ultrasounds with counseling and the other aimed at medical abortions
- ___ AFFIRMATIVE ACTION _ Oklahoma voters approve measure banning affirmative action
- ___ DROUGHT AND WILDFIRES _ Drought impacts ranchers and farmers, and contribute to wildfires in much of the state, damage homes in Luther and near Tulsa
- ___ DRUG CARTEL - HORSES _ Feds raid horse track in Oklahoma amid allegations that a Mexican drug cartel was using the animals to launder drug money
- ___ DUFFEL BAG BODY _ Two men charged in dismemberment and death of Oklahoma teen whose body was found in a duffel bag.
- ___ EXECUTIONS _ Oklahoma’s death chamber sees brisk business as the state executes inmates despite turmoil over access to lethal drugs.
- ___ EX-SENATOR INDICTED _ Former Senate President Pro Tem Mike Morgan convicted of a federal bribery charge
- ___ FIVE DEAD PLEA _ Oklahoma man avoids death penalty, pleads guilty to first-degree murder in deaths of woman and her four children
- ___ GARTH BROOKS _ Country singer wins lawsuit against hospital over donation
- ___ GOOD FRIDAY KILLINGS _ Three people are killed and two injured in a Tulsa shooting spree that prosecutors say was racially motivated
- ___ HEALTH CARE _ Gov. Mary Fallin rejects state-run health insurance exchange, Medicaid expansion
- ___ HOBBY LOBBY LAWSUIT _ Hobby Lobby sues the federal government over its mandate to cover the morning-after pill and other forms of birth control
- ___ INCOME TAX CUT FAILURE _ Gov. Mary Fallin and GOP legislative leaders fail to reach agreement on plan to slash the state’s income tax rate during waning days of 2012 session.
- ___ KEYSTONE PIPELINE _ President Obama visits a state where he didn’t win a single county and touts a cross-country pipeline.
- ___ NARCONON DEATHS _ Local sheriff launches investigation after three deaths in nine months (two in 2012) at an eastern Oklahoma drug rehab center with ties to the Church of Scientology.
- ___ OKLAHOMA STATE-WILLIAMS _ Former Oklahoma State basketball player Darrell Williams receives suspended sentence and is ordered to register as a sex offender after he’s convicted of rape
- ___ OPEN CARRY _ Lawmakers approve open carry in Oklahoma; effective Nov. 1



- ___ PERSONHOOD-OKLAHOMA _ State Supreme Court halts proposed ballot measure to grant personhood rights to embryos
- ___ SULLIVAN LOSS _ Navy pilot Jim Bridenstine unseats long-time U.S. Rep. John Sullivan in the Republican primary.
- ___ THUNDER FINALS _ Oklahoma City Thunder make it to NBA championships but lose to Miami.
- ___ TORNADOES _ 6 killed when tornadoes hit Woodward.
- ___ TRAIN COLLISION _ Two trains collide in Goodwell, killing 3
- ___ TULANE PLAYER HURT _ Tulane player seriously hurt at Tulsa football game
- ___ UNREPORTED RAPE _ Guilty plea in a church rape, and five employees of a Tulsa megachurch face misdemeanor charges after prosecutors accuse them of waiting two weeks to report the rape of a 13-year-old girl to police
- ___ WEST NILE WORSENS _ Oklahoma has a record 176 cases and 12 deaths due to virus in 2012, breaking mark from 2007
